GUEST POLICIES

We welcome guests of our members at the Mandell Jewish Community Center. In order to ensure the safety and security of all our member, participants and staff, we ask that those who invite guests please adhere to the following policies:

- All guests must show a photo ID (license or high school ID) and be signed in at the Member Services Center. Children without a photo ID must have a parent or legal guardian present at the time of check in.
Violation of this policy will result in a minimum of two months suspension and/or up to revoking of all membership privileges.
- A member must accompany every guest. A guest will not be allowed in the facility without the host member.
- Any individual may be a guest of the JCC a maximum of three times in a calendar year. Out of the area guests are exempt from the 3 visit maximum.
- Members ages 10-18 may bring in a maximum of 2 guests per day.
- The JCC may institute usage, age, and hour restrictions with or without prior notice to ensure the safety and comfort of our members.
- The JCC reserves the right to limit the number of guests admitted during peak times as well as deny admittance to local guests who have exceeded the limit of three (3) visits per calendar year.
- Guest passes may be purchased at the Member Services Center. The guest pass fees are \$10 for 18+ and \$8 for children under 17 (max. \$25 per family) per day.
- During peak season (November – April) guest guidelines may be modified. Please see Member Services Center.
